The Trinity is, in the language of the Church:

*One God in three coeternal,  
consubstantial persons.*

Why study the Trinity?

To believe rightly about Jesus - to know Him  
as “the only begotten son\*” of God -  
immediately immerses you in the Trinity.

\*Jn 3:16

The Trinity is God’s self-disclosure.
