6. Is waiting on the Lord in prayer something you find easy or difficult to do?
Explain why.
7. Why should we be watching for those kairos opportunities?
Have you experienced something you would say was a kairos moment?
8. Is there something now in your life for which you are waiting upon the Lord in prayer and you are watching for God’s timing?
