**Icebreaker:**

**Read:**

Luke 2:1-14; John 1:1-4; Philippians 2:5-11

**Discussion Questions:**

1. Of the 4 things we looked at from Luke 2, which one in particular stood out to you and why?
2. Why do you think it isn't always easy to see God's orchestration of events? What factors into why or how we might miss seeing His work?  
  
And on the other side, why would we want to be somewhat cautious about mistaking what God is or isn't doing?
3. How easy or difficult is it for you to say, “Even so Lord, I will trust in you”?
4. Why did our salvation require Jesus to be born in flesh as fully man and fully God?  
Why both and not just one or the other?
5. Why then can't we call Jesus just a great spiritual teacher or a great religious leader?  
Why can't we say there are many ways to God?
