 - The townspeople?
 - The woman?
 - Jesus?
3. How do we get past the barriers (racial, social, economic, ethnic) we may experience with people in our communities?
4. Do you believe people of other faiths or those people who are “really good” and try to help others need Jesus? Explain your answer.
5. How many people were involved in your coming to faith in Jesus Christ?

When you think of sharing your faith or inviting people to join you at church, how does it help you to think that God is already at work in the person’s life?

6. Describe how living out the Shema can help us “harvest our fields”?

What is the greatest challenge you face in doing this?

7. Who are the people in and outside your field?
