**Icebreakers:**

**Review:** Take time to read through Acts 27:1 - 28:16 (Paul’s whole ship voyage). Can you see God’s intent for Paul to get to Rome? Below is the map shown Sunday of Paul’s journey from Jerusalem to Rome.



**Discussion Questions:**

1. When or where is it difficult to trust that God is in control? That he is kind?
2. Share a time or an event in your life when it was difficult to see the Lord at work. Was it easier to see his purposes afterwards?
3. It was a big deal during the 1<sup>st</sup> century that Paul served a God who was in control of the seas. What part of our culture particularly needs God’s rule and reign today?
4. God’s purpose for Paul was to bring him to Rome. Where is the Lord accomplishing his purposes in your life? Why is it easy or difficult to see this?
