Discussion Questions:

2. Have you ever been exposed to the teachings of “the prosperity gospel,” or “gospel lite”?

In what ways have you experienced these teachings?

3. What do you do (or what might you do) to make sure your faith is “right” and “true”?

What are some obvious signs of a faith that is – off?

4. Check out these passages: Acts 23:1, 24:16; Rom.9:1; 1 Cor. 4:4, 8:7-12, 10:25-29; Titus 1:15; Heb. 9:9 & 14, 10:22; 1 Pet. 3:16 & 21.

From these, what are your observations about conscience in the scriptures?

How often do we tend to think about our conscience?

How do we know if it is good or when it is bad?

What are ways to pay more attention to it?
