

## CENTERPOINT DISASTER RESPONSE TEAM PARTNERS WITH SAMARITAN'S PURSE TO REBUILD HOMES IN TEXAS



Centerpoint sent a team to the Houston area for one week in April to help rebuild homes destroyed by last year's hurricane. We partnered with Samaritan's Purse who will be in the Greater Houston area for the next two years assisting homeowners who have no insurance or can't afford to rebuild. The team consisted of Mark Janzen, Greg and Laura Odenthal, Curtis and Tanya Flores, Sharon Wurst, John Sprague, and Ruth Ault.

### Here's what team member Laura Odenthal had to say about the experience:

*"This was my first opportunity to serve with Samaritan's Purse and the experience was incredible. Their commitment to restore or replace 1,000 homes in the Hurricane Harvey damage region is a huge one but the staff and volunteers are in it for the long haul. If one has never served with Samaritan's Purse, I urge them to try it. They are well organized with qualified construction managers leading the teams and a loving, caring support staff."*

In appreciation and support for their work, Centerpoint has gifted \$3,000 to Samaritan's Purse. The monies were granted to the Local Missions committee by Centerpoint's Partners in Outreach Foundation to be used to further the Lord's work within the context of missions.

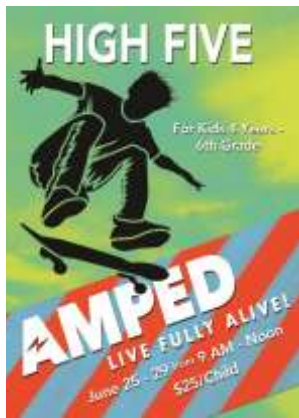
