Discussion Questions:

1. Read John 10:11-18. Review how many times Jesus says he lays down his life.
Why do you think he repeated it so many times?

2. Review what was the Jewish Sanhedrin. Why did they want to do away with Jesus?

What were they afraid of?

Why couldn't they charge him with rebellion against the Romans?

What did they charge him with?

How is the charge true and not true?

3. What did Pilate charge and execute Jesus for?

How was the charge true and not true?

4. While both the Jewish leaders and Pilate were complicit in Jesus' death, how does John 10:18 and Isaiah 53:5-6 speak against their being the ones who are to blame for his death?

5. How far should we go in feeling the weight and the guilt of having caused Jesus' death?

What response(s) to having been the cause of Jesus' sacrificial death is God ultimately looking for from us? (Check out Romans 6:8-18, 8:1-17; 2 Corinthians 5:14-21; Ephesians 5:1-2; Hebrews 9:11-15)
