Week of May 6, 2018

Icebreakers:

- *Have you ever gone fishing? What was a memorable moment?*
- *What’s the best breakfast you ever had? Why was it great?*

Review: Look back at Luke 5:1-11 & John 21:1-14. Compare the two great catches and the conversations afterwards. What is similar? What is different?

Discussion Questions:

1. In both passages, Jesus’ instructions did not make sense to the fishermen. How do you react when God’s instructions don’t make sense to you?
2. Share a time in your life when God did something impossible that “rocked your boat.”
3. Compare “fishing for people” with “shepherding” God’s flock. What does it mean to fish? To shepherd? Are these commands only for Peter, or are they for all Christians? Why?
4. What is one situation in your life currently where God is saying, “What is that to you? You must follow me” (John 21:22)?
