Discussion Questions:

1. Read John 1:4,5 and 9. How has Christ been a light, and a light of life to you?

2. What does the Bible mean when it talks about someone walking in darkness? (i.e. Matthew 4:16)

3. Do you agree that while Jesus says we will never walk *in* darkness if we follow him, there are times we walk into it, or into shadows in our lives?

If you have ever experienced that what did it feel like?

What can we do in those times to remind ourselves of, and to find again, the light of Christ?

4. On Sunday (or at the end of the podcast) where did you sense Jesus was calling you to be a light bearer for Him?

How will you shine Christ’s light there?
