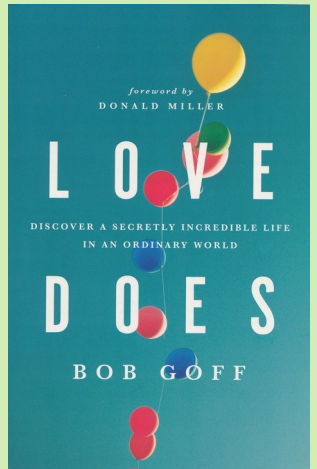


Upcoming Women's Class

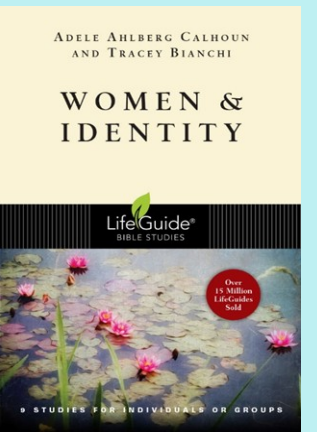


Ongoing Study
